

MOST DIFFICULT. This route ascends steeply uphill, plateaus, then takes a left hand turn (B) uphill into the woods. From here the path is narrow, steep in spots, and includes short rock step ups and downs. It does provide a spectacular view of the front side of the

THE APPROACH. No matter which trail you use, the last 100m scramble onto Castle Rock can be a challenge. Scout out the route that is best for you. When descending, remember to go
