BUILD PROCESS

Our homes are built by Supreme Homes in a state-of-the-art climate-controlled facility located in Tracadie-Sheila, NB.

After the factory portion of the build is complete, the home is transported to your prepared site via truck. In some cases, a crane is used to lift the home onto its pad or foundation.

Traditional building methods are used to finish the home on-site after delivery. Once complete, you'll do a full walk-through with your consultant to ensure everything is as it should be.

ADVANTAGES

- Build timelines are usually much quicker than site-built homes

WARRANTY

All of our homes come with a 1-year manufacturer's warranty provided by Supreme Homes and a 2-year water penetration & 8-year structural LUX Residential Warranty program.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

The first deposit is 10% of the purchase price of your new home. This payment is due at the signing of our Agreement of Purchase and Sale. This initial deposit puts your name in the queue for the construction of your home.

The second payment is 80% of the purchase price. This payment is due on or before the delivery of the home to your site.

The remaining 10% payment is due at the closing of your new home after all of the on-site finish work is complete. Homeowners will receive their keys and take possession of the home when the final payment is received in full.

What is the difference between a mini home and a modular home?

A mini home is built in a single section whereas a modular home is built in multiple sections. Every home, mini or modular, is built using the same high-quality materials by skilled tradespeople. A mini home is 95% finished upon delivery, whereas a modular home requires roughly 6-8 weeks of on-site finishing work to complete the build.

Why are there no prices listed on your website or social media?

Each and every home is custom built and priced individually. This is why there isn't a one-size-fits-all price for each model. Factors that affect pricing include: building location, foundation type, the size of the home and intricacy of the design, and the unique finishes selected by each client.

What are the foundation options?

Our modular homes require a frost wall (crawl space) or a full basement. While mini homes can also be placed on a frost wall or a basement, they can alternatively be installed on screw piles (metal posts) or concrete blocking. If you choose screw piles or blocking for your mini home, a skirting system is required.

Can I make changes to the layout and finishes?

Yes! Adjustments can be made to the size of the home, the layout, and the finishes (interior and exterior). We want your new home to be exactly that, yours.

Do I have to choose a plan from your website?

Not necessarily. While Supreme Homes offers a large selection of customizable mini and modular home layouts, we can also work from a pre-existing plan that you love or create a custom plan from scratch.

What if I'm out of the province?

No problem! We've worked with many clients living outside of NS to build their dream homes on the east coast.

Do you offer financing?
