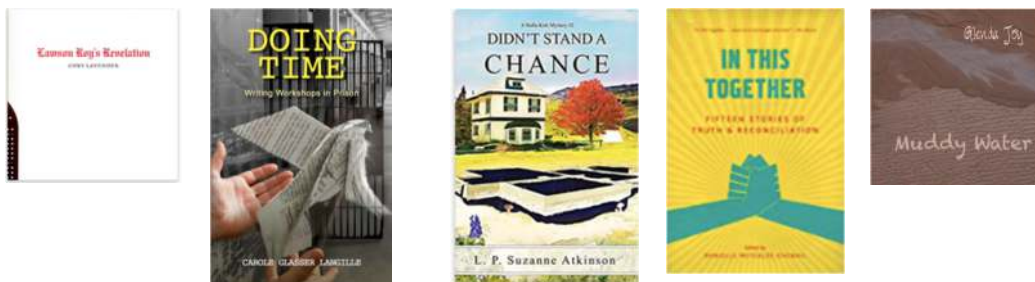


**Hubbards Community Event

Cory Lavender – will give a “spirited reading” from his poetic works. His poetic works have been published in Riddle Fence, Halifax (Frog Hollow Press), Gaspereau Press and online at The Island Review.

Glenda Joy Pennell – Singer/songwriter performing from her CD *Muddy Waters* – all original lyrics.

Danielle Metcalfe Chenail, new to Nova Scotia, is currently writing women's fiction. Danielle will read excerpts from her works published by Robin Brass Studio, Dundurn, Brindle & Glass/Touchwood Editions and Tundra Books.

Authors will have a book available for signing and purchase.

Well-known Nova Scotia writer Philip Moscovitch, from Glen Margaret – author of *Adventures in Bubbles and Brine* – will MC this event.
